

Snapshot and Recorder Installation & Navigation Guide

macOS



OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder is OKIOCAM's principal application. This guide will walk you through how to install it on macOS.



In a web browser, go to the OKIOLABS download page (**www.okiolabs.** com/download/).



Click on **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder** to start the download.



After the download has completed, click on the **Downloads** folder.







Click on **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder** to start the installation.





Click on **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder** and drag and drop it to **Applications**.









Locate OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder in the Applications folder. Right click on **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder** and click on **Open**.







A dialog box will pop up asking you to confirm that you wish to open OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder. Click **Open**.





After Snapshot and Recorder has opened, a dialog box will appear asking you to confirm that you want to allow OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder access to your camera. Click **OK**.

Click the **OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder icon** on the Dock to launch OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder in the future.



If you have Mac OS X 10.6.6 or later, you can also install OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder via the Mac App Store.

Use the **Zoom** control to adjust the level of zoom. Press the \bigcirc and \bigcirc icons to adjust the level of zoom in increments of .1x, between 1x and 6x. Zoom can also be adjusted using the slider by left-clicking on \bigcirc and dragging the mouse either up or down.

Use the **Rotate** control to rotate the camera display clockwise and counterclockwise in increments of 90°. rotates the camera display clockwise and rotates counterclockwise.



Use the **Exposure** control to adjust the level of exposure. Press the \bigcirc and \bigcirc icons to adjust the level of exposure in increments of 1, between -7 and +7. Exposure can also be adjusted using the slider by left-clicking on \bigcirc and dragging the mouse either up or down.



Press the **Freeze** button to freeze the camera feed.



Press the **Focus / Auto adjust** button to adjust the camera's focus, exposure, and white balance automatically.



Press the **Reset** button to reset the camera.

- From the **Camera** drop-down menu, you can choose which camera you want to use with OKIOCAM Snapshot and Recorder.
- Use the **Resolution** drop-down menu to select which resolution you would like to view the Live View and take your snapshots in. Available resolutions will depend on which camera you are using.
- Use the **Focus Sound** drop-down menu to select whether you want to hear a sound after the camera has finished focusing.
- Change the Library
 Folder by clicking on the Change icon.
 The Library Folder is the directory that your OKIOCAM
 Snapshot and
 Recorder files are stored in on your
 computer.

The resolutions available when using both OKIOCAM S and OKIOCAM T

- Use the Ratio drop-down menu to choose the aspect ratio that videos are recorded in (choose from either 4:3 or 16:9).
- Select the quality that videos are recorded in. Choose from either Low or High. Recorded video resolution will depend on which aspect ratio you have selected.
- If you want to record audio, choose which microphone you want to record from using the **Recording Mic** dropdown menu. If you do not want to record audio, select **None**.
- Set the microphone volume using the slider in the Mic Volume section. Drag the 💽 icon towards the right to raise the recording volume and towards the left to lower the recording volume. Set the **Display** when recording setting to the on position (() if you want to have the ability to adjust the microphone volume directly from within the Live View when recording, and set it to the off position () if you do not.

- Use the drop-down menus to reassign different functions to the physical buttons on the camera.
- Choose the zoom ratios that will be cycled through when the button assigned to the zoom function is pressed. Input custom zoom ratios if you wish.

- Assign a shutter timer time of either 0, 2, or 5 seconds using the **Shutter Timer** dropdown menu. The shutter timer triggers every time you take a snapshot.
- If Post-Shot Review is set to Yes, after you take a snapshot you will be taken directly to Review Mode. If it is set to No, you will not be.
